Commencement ceremony tickets

- Each graduate will receive 8 tickets for the ceremony. These will be available for pick-up at Grad Fair. Additional information regarding Grad Fair follows.
- Every guest (including children) attending the Commencement ceremony must have a ticket. A ticket will not be required for an infant ("babe in arms").
- For those guests who will require special accommodation seating, both a ceremony ticket and a seating pass will be required for access to the special accommodation seating area. Please refer to the information below for additional details regarding how to secure a special accommodation seating pass.
- All extra tickets should be returned to One Stop to redistribute as needed.
- Any tickets not picked up by Friday, April 12, may be redistributed to students as extra tickets.
- Reasonable requests for additional tickets may be made at Grad Fair (on Tuesday April 2) or at One Stop between Wednesday, March 20 and Friday, April 12. Should additional tickets be available, main campus students can pick up additional tickets



beginning Monday, April 15. The deadline to pick up additional tickets is Friday, April 29.

Cap and Gown

- The cost of one cap and gown was included in your graduation fee.
- These will be available for pick-up at Grad Fair. Please continue reading for more information about the event.
- Additional caps, tassels, or other related items may be purchased at the bookstore.
- Be sure to try on your gown and zip it to ensure proper fit at least a few days prior to the ceremony. If the gown does not fit, you can exchange it at the bookstore in its original packaging.
- Be sure to hang up your gown a few days prior to the ceremony to allow the wrinkles to relax. You may steam your gown, if necessary, but ironing the garment is not recommended.
- If you are not able to pick up your cap and gown, send an email to the bookstore at 0291mgr@follett.com to request that your cap and gown be mailed to you. In your request, include your name, student ID number, height and weight, and your mailing address so your cap and gown can be shipped to you.

o For those unable to attend Grad Fair:

- Caps and gowns may be picked up at the bookstore.
- Bring your photo ID.
- The bookstore is open Monday through Thursday from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. and Friday from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
- Commencement tickets can be picked up April 3 thru April 19 at One Stop. One Stop is open Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Students who want to request more tickets may do so at One Stop during the time listed above. If you are not able to go to One Stop, you can email One Stop at sos@wilmington.edu and request to have your tickets mailed to you.

Special Accommodation seating area

- The Commencement ceremony will be held in Hermann Court, which offers stadium seating on one side (seats with backs) and bleacher seating on the other (seats with no backs). There are no handrails ascending into either of these seating areas and the steps are steep. Special Accommodation seats are reserved for individuals in wheelchairs or those who cannot easily navigate the stairs.
- We request an early arrival for our guests who will need to sit in the special accommodation seating area. Early arrival begins at 9:30 a.m. to ensure that all our guests will be seated by 10:15 a.m. when the processional starts.
- Guests not requiring accessible seating may enter Hermann Court at 9:30 a.m. No one will be permitted to enter Hermann Court during the processional which will begin at 10:15 a.m.

Special Accommodation Guest Drop-off/Parking

For ground level access to seating, guests who will be in the Special Accommodations area should be dropped off behind Hermann Court. Commencement staff will be available to assist guests to their seats. All cars will need to be parked in the designated parking lots.

Student Accounts

- Student accounts must be paid-in-full by April 19
- Payments may be made online or by check at the One Stop.
- o Balances must be paid-in-full before your diploma and transcript can be mailed. The approximate date for diplomas and transcripts to be mailed is June 15.

FAQ's

What should I wear besides my cap and gown?



- Commencement is a formal occasion and appropriate attire under your gown is required. For the ceremony, it is suggested you wear comfortable shoes (please, no flip flops) and men should wear pants (not shorts). Keep in mind that the gym is not air conditioned. Depending on the weather, it can get very hot in Hermann Court! Do not iron your gown, but please hang it up or steam it to remove creases before the ceremony.
- What can I bring to the ceremony?
 - Do not bring anything that you can't carry in your pocket under your robe. There is no option for securing personal property during the ceremony. We strongly discourage carrying large items (e.g., balloons or bouquets).
- What about transcripts?
 - One complimentary copy of your final transcript and your diploma will be mailed to your home address by late June for Spring graduates (provided your student account is clear with Student Accounts). Additional copies of transcripts may be requested through http://www.wilmington.edu by clicking on *Request Transcript* at the bottom of the first page. There is a fee for additional transcripts.
